This is to legally notify you that on Thursday June 5 2003, a civil action was filed in the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, in which you have been named a defendant.

You have 2 options at this point.

1) You can voluntarily accept service of process (summons). To do this, you must either respond to this email or send a facsimile including the street address (no PO Boxes) at which you would like the summons to be delivered to you personally. The summons will then be sent by certified mail, return receipt, restricted delivery. This will require you to be personally present and sign the receipt in front of the postal clerk.

2) You can refuse to voluntarily accept service of summons. After which, the summons will be delivered to you by a County Sheriffs officer. If you choose this option, you may be assessed a fee of up to \$200.00 for the cost of service.

If you have not responded to this message by 5:00pm, Friday, June 13 2003, it will be considered a refusal to voluntarily accept service.
