Dear Mr. McNair.

This is in response to your letter of June 28, 2004 entitled Notice of Claims and Attention Janice Stratton. Your letter addressed to me, recites again, in large part, the allegations that you have previously made against the county and certain individuals.

You continually make accusations of me refusing and not properly responding to your correspondence. A substantial portion of your correspondence is repetitive and has been previously addressed. Other portions of your correspondence entail legally improper procedural and substantive matters. While you continually plea with the court and the merit commission for leniency and a waiver of formal requirements for yourself, I must uphold the process requirements set forth for application of the appropriate law. I must remind you that it would be totally improper, and in fact, a violation of my ethics to provide you legal advice to remedy the deficiencies in your claims and their proceedings. I urge you to seek qualified legal counsel for those matters.

On the last page of your Notice of Claims letter it appears that you are asking me to accept service. I am not aware that you have properly served any of my clients related to a new matter and I am not authorized to accept service on their behalf at this time.

Your letter of June 28, 2004, addressed to the attention of Janice Stratton, was forwarded to me for my review. You were previously advised in a letter on October 23, 2002, that your records demand does not satisfy the statutory requirements for free copies. Once again you demand records and once again the response has not changed since your last demand. Certainly you are not asking the county to act in an illegal manner by providing you free copies?

Furthermore, note that the county is not obligated to continually respond to your repetitive demands.
